BioTexas in Boston for Annual BIO Convention

AUSTIN, TX – May 19, 2023 – The Texas Healthcare and Bioscience Institute (THBI) will host the BioTexas Pavilion at the 2023 BIO International Convention in Boston, MA, June 5-8. Each year, THBI organizes a delegation from Texas to showcase the state's thriving biotechnology and life sciences sector at the world's largest biotechnology conference.

The BIO International Convention is the largest global event for the biotechnology industry and attracts the biggest names in biotech, offers key networking and partnering opportunities, and provides insights and inspiration on the major trends affecting the industry. More than 16,000 biotechnology and pharmaceutical leaders are expected to attend the annual gathering.

Texas is home to more than 7,400 life science businesses and over 116,000 employees in related fields.
