HB 1810, Capriglione

Summary: maintenance and production of electronic public information by a governmental body/state entity. Defines electronic public information in statute.

HB 1935, Bucy

Summary: Amends Occupations Code relating to pharmacy and pharmacists. Allows pharmacists to provide an emergency refill of insulin and insulin-related equipment or supplies. Emergency refill may not exceed a 30-day supply.

SB 674, Buckingham

Summary: Amends the enacting statute of the Health and Human Services Commission and the agency's Medicaid managed care program statute in the Government Code. The bill prohibits the executive commissioner from requiring clinical, nonpreferred, or other prior authorization for antipsychotic prescription drugs for adult patients under the prior authorization for certain prescription drugs and Medicaid managed care program if certain criteria are met.

SB 679, Kolkhorst

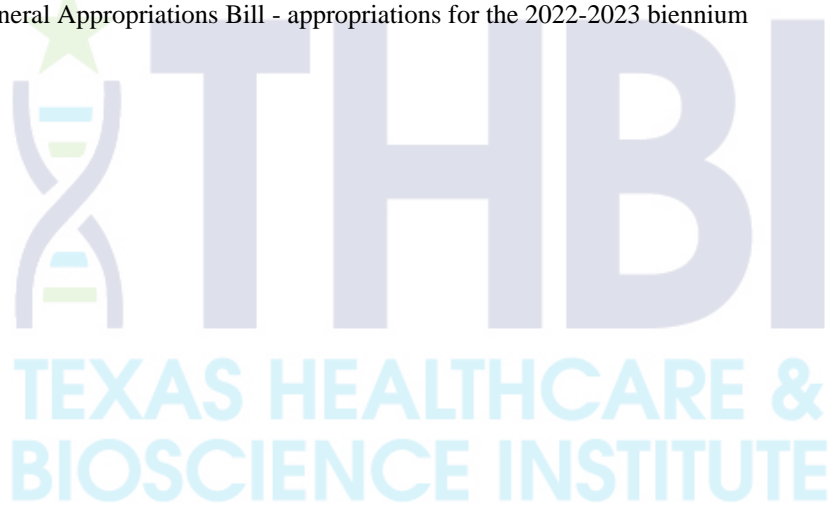

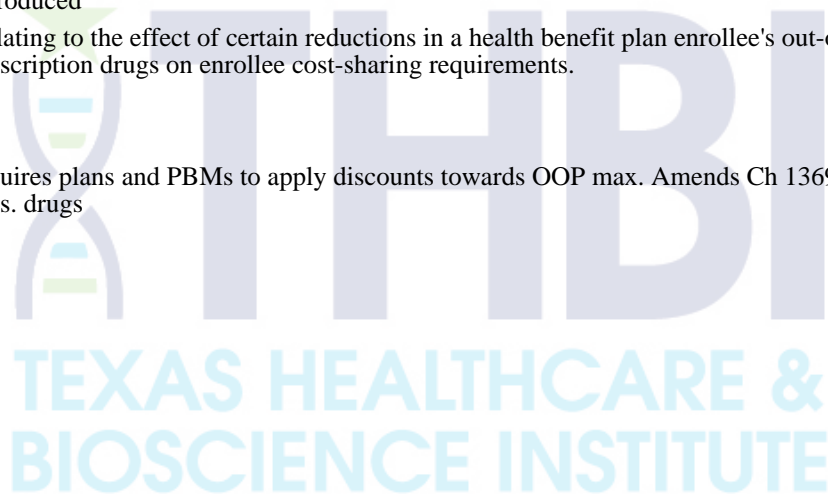
